

For many, 2021 was a year of cautious return: Bars and restaurants slowly re-opened, long-delayed family gatherings and weddings were held, travel resumed in fits and starts. Often, that included special pours to celebrate those moments, from limited-edition whiskeys and brandies to fun, ultraportable canned cocktails.

This list represents the most memorable spirits we've had the opportunity to review over the past 12 months. It spans a broad range of categories and price points, from a pair of lively \$20 lemon liqueurs to a rare—but spectacular—Irish whiskey finished in Cognac casks, priced at a stratospheric \$500. You'll find a range of vodkas, both flavored and neutral, that will liven up your cocktail game, and a slew of brandies—from Armagnac to Calvados and more—that will serve as the perfect cold-weather sippers.

While spirits were selected for this list based on their quality, it's also satisfying to zoom out and note the broadening diversity of the people behind the bottles. Whatever you're looking to celebrate, even if it's just making it through another challenging year, grab a glass, because this list is full of exciting bottles to try.

WINE ENTHUSIAST TOP 100 SPIRITS | 2021

BOURBON

Barrell Private Release A01A Bourbon (USA; Barrell Craft Spirits, Louisville, KY). Concentrated toffee aromas entice on the nose. While this cask-strength beast opens fiery, adding just enough water brings out a bright and fruity side: Dried cherry, orange and lemon peel slide into vanilla and caramel. The spicy finish is tinged with fleeting espresso and campfire smoke, too. This is a limited-edition micro blend of bourbons aged five to 15 years, with 70% of the blend 15 years old.

95 18th Street Distillery Spirit Thief Selection Bourbon (USA; 18th Street Distillery, Hammond, IN). Complex aromas include dried fig, dried cherry and vanilla. The palate opens with spice and dark fruit, similar to Port or PX Sherry. Adding water melds everything together into rich fruitcake studded with raisin, dried cherry and candied orange peel, finishing long with nutmeg and cinnamon accents. Each sip warms all the way down. Single Barrel #17-0037.

95 Angel's Envy Finished in Japanese Mizunara Oak Casks Bourbon (USA; Angel's Envy; Louisville, KY). This was released in September 2020 to celebrate the brand's 10th anniversary. Look for a copper penny hue and rich caramel and toffee aromas. The bold palate opens with espresso, clove and a drying hint of plum skin. Adding water softens the heat and brings more oak forward, along with accents of mocha and vanilla, finishing long with black pepper heat. Available only at distillery.

95 Old Fitzgerald Bottled-in-Bond Spring 2020 Edition (USA; Heaven Hill, Bardstown, KY). The mild caramel aroma is just a preview for what is to come. The palate is deep and bold, showing toffee and espresso flavors that lighten to a mocha character. Lemony brightness and mouthwatering clove mark the finish.

94 Kuiper Belt Aged 8 Years Straight Kentucky Bourbon (USA; Wine and Spirits Spoken Here, Napa, CA). Named for a ring of icy bodies that orbit the sun, this small-batch whiskey is aged, as the producer says, "eight earth orbits around the sun." Look for a gentle cinnamon scent and a spicy-sweet palate. Adding water plays up the caramel note and layers on succulent toffee richness. It's robust enough to enjoy with a big cube of ice or mixed into an Old Fashioned. aby: 45%

94 Redwood Empire Pipe Dream Bourbon (USA; Redwood Empire, Sonoma County, CA). Mild oak and vanilla aromas lead the nose. The robust palate opens with a dusting of cocoa. Adding water transforms that into milk chocolate and vanilla richness. Each sip exits with black pepper and a lemony zing. Aged at least four years.

94 Winchester Double Oak Kentucky Straight Bourbon Whiskey Finished With Sherry Cask Staves (USA; Green River Distilling, Owensboro, KY). This bourbon finished with Sherry cask staves drinks almost like a rum. Brown butter mingles with banana breadlike tropical fruit, nutmeg, maple and cinnamon, plus a lip-smacking lemon peel hint in the finish. Best Buy.

Blue Note Juke Joint Bourbon (USA; B.R. Distilling, Memphis, TN). Butterscotch and maple aromas meet with candied orange peel on the nose. The palate is similarly bold and rich, with creamy caramel and a smoky hint winding into ginger and lemon peel on the exit. Sip or mix. Distilled in Kentucky, bottled in Tennessee. Aged a minimum of three years. Best Buy.

93 Four Roses 2020 Limited Edition Small Batch Barrel Strength (USA; Four Roses, Lawrenceburg, KY). A blend of whiskies aged 12, 16 and 19 years, this bourbon has a rich toffee aroma. Add plenty of water to this overproof bottling, which tames the considerable alcohol heat and releases soft vanilla and caramel tones plus a fleeting bright cherry note. The elongated finish eases into mellow baking spice. **abv:** 55.65% **Price:** \$150

George Remus Bourbon (USA; MGP, Lawrenceburg, IN). Bold oak and vanilla aromas lead the nose. The bright palate sizzles with cinnamon spice around a caramel core. Adding water brings out a sarsaparilla note alongside more cinnamon, cayenne heat and a nutty tone. It warms all the way down.

Milam & Greene Single Barrel Straight Bourbon (USA; Milam & Greene, Blanco, TX). Expect a light honey hue, with maple and almond aromas. The palate echoes that maple note, alongside clove and espresso, anchored by oak. Adding water unleashes mouthwatering butterscotch and unsweetened chocolate. A faint glimmer of clove heat leads into the gentle finish.

Navigator Straight Bourbon (USA; Precision Wine and Spirit, Sonoma, CA). This is a Kentucky bourbon aged three years in American oak, then finished in Cabernet Sauvignon casks from Napa Valley's Navigator. The end result is a mellow sipper, with bright aromas that suggest golden raisin and peach nectar. The palate has a Sherry-like quality, showing dried fruit and a floral hint, finishing long on almond and lemon.

Peerless Small Batch Kentucky Straight Bourbon (USA; Peerless Distilling, Louisville, KY).

The bold, slightly smoky aroma teases the nose. The palate opens with ribbons of toffee sweetness intertwined with clove, cardamom and black pepper. Adding water amps up the spice, layering on cinnamon and cayenne heat. The long finish surprises with an orange peel note.

Germain Robin California Alambic Brandy
Aged 7 Years (USA; Germain Robin, Modesto,

CA). This is made with California grapes, distilled and aged in the style of Cognac. It's stunning from start to finish. Vanilla and baked apple richness give way to lots of deep, dusty cocoa and a hint of walnut, finishing lightly with a lively flurry of baking spice and a faint note of dried apricot.

Claque-Pepin Vieille Reserve Organic Calvados (France; Heavenly Spirits, Lakeville, MA). Hitting all the right notes, this shows fresh apple and vanilla aromas that lead into a rich butterscotch and honey palate. The feather-light finish shows salted caramel, roasted nuts, cinnamon and clove.

96 Laird's 10th Generation Bottled in Bond Aged 5 Years Apple Brandy (USA; Laird & Company, Scobeyville, NJ). This substantial sipper has a copper hue and a baked apple aroma. The plush palate opens with lots of caramel and spice. A splash of water brings out hints of tobacco and cigar wrapper, finishing with baked apple, cinnamon and clove. Aged five years and bottled in bond, this bottling commemorates the 10th generation of Laird's making apple spirits.

94 Catoctin Creek Quarter Branch Virginia Apple Brandy (USA; Catoctin Creek, Purcellville,

VA). Look for a bright topaz hue and a velvety caramel tone on nose and palate. Lush toffee leads into mouthwatering flickers of cocoa and tropical fruit, finishing long with clove and black pepper heat. Blue Bee Cider made the base then Catoctin distilled and aged the liquid.

93 Chateau de Laubade 21 Years Old Bas Armagnac (France; Baron Francois, New York,

NY). Maple and caramel aromas lead the nose. The first spicy sips smolder with cayenne and cinnamon, smoothed by vanilla and orange peel tones. The long finish offers mouthwatering hints of plum, ripe peach and a final echo of spice.

Purchase, NY). Look for a notably deep amber hue and caramel aroma. The lively palate opens with caramel, spice, cocoa and plenty of oomph, finishing gracefully and long with ribbons of cocoa and vanilla intertwined with nutmeg and allspice sparks.

Traverse City Whiskey Co. Experimental Series Apple Brandy (USA; Traverse City Whiskey Co., Traverse City, MI). Made with Michigan apples and aged in used bourbon barrels, this brandy has a mild red fruit and vanilla scent but is bold and mouthfilling at first sip. Vanilla bean and maple layer with cinnamon spice. A much-needed splash of water brings out mocha tones. Bottled in bond at 100 proof.

Barking Irons Applejack (USA; Black Dirt Distillery, Pine Island, NY). This was made with New York State apples and aged at Brooklyn's Van Brunt Stillhouse for a minimum of three months. Vanilla and fresh pear aromas lead into a vanilla wafter palate tinged with coconut and lightened with a minty tingle. Recommended to mix.

Bhakta 50 Armagnac (France; Bhakta Farms, Shoreham, VT). From the founder of WhistlePig, what's in the bottle is a blend of old Armagnacs—the youngest is 50 years old, the oldest was distilled in 1868—finished in Islay whisky casks. The nose is all luscious crème brûlée, but the palate shows little of that. Cinnamon and black pepper are followed by surprising mesquite and bacon fat notes. The finish is more delicate, with hints of dried apricot, chamomile tea and cigar wrapper leading into a lightly smoky and spicy exhale.

Daron Fine Calvados (France; WJ Deutsch & Sons, Stamford, CT). A mix of apple and pear plus a hint of funk defines the nose. The mild palate leans toward fresh and baked apple slicked with honey, finishing drying and brisk with ginger and clove heat. Sip or mix.

Tattersall Apple Brandy (USA; Tattersall Distilling, Minneapolis, MN). Made with organic apples from Minnesota orchards and aged in new oak barrels, the end result is a golden hue and woody aroma, with just a hint of fruit. The palate is light and custardy, suggesting vanilla cream and lemon cream pie, finishing brisk with nutmeg, cedar, ginger and clove.

St. George California Reserve Apple Brandy (USA; St. George Spirits, Alameda, CA). Made with Mendocino County apples, this was aged in a mix of used American whiskey casks and used American and French wine casks. The bulk of the blend is between six and seven years old. The finished brandy has a tawny hue and distinctly floral character. Apple blossom and carnation entwine with mild almond and cream soda on nose and palate, enhanced by mulling spices and baked apple. Lot 2020.

Salcombe Gin Rosé Sainte Marie (England; Park Street Imports, Miami, FL). The bottle is tinted blush pink, but the liquid inside is crystal clear. Grapefruit peel and juniper lead the nose. The brisk, citrusy palate offers lemon and grapefruit peel, plus fleeting berry sweetness midpalate, finishing with a floral exhale. Of note, this gin is inspired by rosé, but is not distilled from wine nor does it contain rosé wine. Martini-worthy.

Listoke 1777 Irish Gin (Ireland; Preiss Imports, Ramona, CA). Comforting gingerbread-like aromas channel allspice, anise and a hint of molasses. The palate is a bit brighter, opening with lemon verbena and pine forest leading to hints of anise, sandalwood and shortbread cookie on the warming exhale. abv: 43.3% **Price:** \$39

Lifited Spirits Bold Gin (USA; Lifted Spirits, Kansas City, MO). Sprightly juniper leads this London dry-style gin on nose and palate, followed by licorice, fennel and a hint of berry sweetness. The lingering finish is laced with black pepper.

Nolet's Silver Gin (Holland; Nolet's, Aliso Viejo, CA). Look for a pale straw hue and floral aromas intertwined with a hint of fruity sweetness. The palate opens with bold violet and rose petal interlaced with anise and juicy berry, finishing with black pepper punch.

Ranch Road Barrel Gin (USA; Chankaska Spirits, Kasota, MN). Look for a burnished gold hue and citrus and butterscotch aromas. The palate is bright, with loads of lemon peel and ginger sparkle, while a lick of brown butter adds richness.

135 East Hyōgo Dry Gin (Japan; Marussia USA, Cedar Knolls, NJ). A lemongrass aroma leads into a lightly sweet, faintly herbaceous palate that finishes with a lingering pink-peppercorn zing. This London dry-style gin is made with Japanese botanicals, including sansho pepper, shiso, yuzu and ume. Best Buy.

North Shore Gin No. 6 (USA; North Shore Dis-L tillery, Green Oaks, IL). This craft gin was reformulated in 2020. It's still spicy, citrusy and bright, though the proof has been nudged slightly higher. Each sip opens with brisk lemon and candied grapefruit peel plus a faint raspberry note, and lands on cubeb pepper and grains of paradise. Best Buy.

Gentilly Gin (USA; Seven Three Distilling, New Orleans, LA). Zingy, savory aromas include green olive and dried oregano. The palate opens with fresh thyme, rosemary and sweet mint, evolving into dried herb notes and finishing assertively with lemon pucker and cracked black pepper.

North Oak Barrel Rested Gin (Hardshore Distilling, Portland, ME). Expect a honey hue with bold vanilla and allspice aromas. The palate shows oak and hints of red fruit and cocoa powder. The long, mouthwatering finish is dusted with cinnamon, nutmeg and clove.

Telluride Gin (USA; Telluride Distilling, Telluride, CO). Mild citrusy aromas lead into a light, spiced palate. Look for a warming mix of aniseed, coriander and cedar moving into a mouthwatering saltand-white pepper finish. Mix into Negronis. Distilled from cane sugar, with botanicals including Rocky Mountain juniper.

The Aimsir Distilling Co. Aitil House Gin (USA; The Aimsir Distilling Co., Portland, OR).

Aitil means juniper in Gaelic. Look for a slightly vegetal aroma, with a hint of star anise. Juniper and pine emerge on the bracing palate. The tingly finish spotlights citrusy notes of lemon, lemon verbena and lemongrass.

Bushmills The Rare Casks 28 Years Limited BUSHMIUS THE ROLE COSTO TO Release No. 01 Cognac Cask Irish Whiskey (Ireland; Proximo Spirits, Jersey City, NJ). This is a single malt distilled in 1992, matured in bourbon and Sherry casks, and finished in Cognac casks. It's a delicious, nuanced dram, with vanilla and fresh-cut red apple on nose and palate and a superlight, almost effervescent texture. A splash of water teases out lemon mousse and a puff of smoke on the exhale.

Drumshanbo Single Pot Still Irish Whiskey (Ireland; Palm Bay International, Port Washington, NY). Richly spiced aromas lead into a smooth, luxurious palate that sinks into flavors of vanilla, dried apricot and dried date. Adding water unlocks more vanilla and sweet spices like clove, cinnamon and nutmeg. This is a big, mouthfilling whiskey to sip with a cube of ice or consider as a dessert pairing.

The Busker Irish Whiskey (Ireland; Disaronno International, Somerset, NJ). Billed as a triple cask whiskey, the liquid was finished in barrels that previously held Sherry, bourbon and Marsala. The result is a cinnamon and faint floral aroma, and a palate that sizzles with baking spice. It eventually mellows into flavors of vanilla wafer, cocoa and dried fig, finishing with gingery zing. Best Buy.

94 The Whistler Oloroso Sherry Cask Finish Irish Whiskey (Ireland; Prestige Beverage, Princeton, MN). The sweet, enticing aroma bursts with dried fruit. Those notes are echoed on the robust palate, showing dried apricot, booze-soaked golden raisins and vanilla flavors that lead into a gentle nutty, gingery finish. Best Buy.

Skilbeggan Single Pot Still Irish Whiskey (Ireland; Beam Suntory, Chicago, IL). Fresh cut apple and a hint of smoke lead the nose. The robust, flavorful palate offers a surprising plummy note, finishing long and drying with cayenne and clove heat. Altogether, the pleasing effect is like spice cake doused in whiskey.

McCabe's Irish Whiskey (Ireland; Hard Truth Distilling, Nashville, IN). Look for a pale gold hue and toasty aroma. The palate shows dusty nutmeg and cayenne spice, coupled with a meaty, umami note. Adding water enhances the spice and brings forward toasted grain, oatmeal cookie and malted milk notes, finishing drying and astringent. This is blended Irish whiskey pot-distilled in Ireland, proofed and bottled in Indiana. Best Buy.

95 Letterpress Limoncello (USA; Letterpress Distilling, Seattle, WA). Richer than a typical limoncello, this golden liqueur offers roasted pineapple and toasted banana bread aromas. An intriguing butterscotch note opens the palate, rounding into a long, honeyed finish enlivened with nutmeg, cayenne and lemon pepper. Mix with rum or stir into cake batter. This is a honey-sweetened homage to the distiller's grandmother's village in the mountains outside of Rome.

Fabrizia Limoncello Cream Liqueur (USA; Fabrizia Spirits, Salem, NH). A refreshing palate cleanser of a cream liqueur, look for a light yellow hue and mild lemon curd aroma. Plush and palate coating, moderately sweet lemon sorbet and lemon cream notes lead into a light finish braced up with ginger. Best Buu.

93 LS Cream Liqueur (USA; L.S. Cream, Jacksonville, FL). Inspired by Haiti's tradition of cremas, typically made with condensed milk, coconut cream and spices, this liqueur has a creamy chocolate milk appearance and enticing vanilla buttercream scent. Each palate-coating sip is creamy and soothing, with hints of brown butter, vanilla and baking spice. Dessert sipper.

92 Chelly Limon Liqueur (USA; Chelly, Tempe, AZ). At 80 proof, this is a bit stronger than most limoncellos. The pale straw hue and pleasing candied lemon peel aroma leads into a clean, snappy palate showing lemon peel and white pepper, finishing surprisingly long. Sip with a cube of ice or lengthen with sparkling water. **Best Buy**.

Jovis Limoncello (Italy; Originals Imports, Stamford, CT). Cloudy, sunny yellow appearance and bright lemon peel aroma. The palate opens sweet and finishes brisk and mouthwatering. In between, candied lemon-peel and lemon lollipop flavors mingle with white pepper and ginger heat. Made with Sorrento lemon peels, no preservatives or colorants.

92 Ver Liqueur (USA; Elixir, Eugene, OR). An American-made take on herbal liqueurs like absinthe or pastis, expect a pale olive hue and anise and fennel-seed aromas. Add water to take the edge off this 100-proof spirit. The result is hypnotic haziness and amped-up licorice and anise, accented with hints of tarragon and fresh fennel, winding into peppery sting. Sip, mix or use as a glass rinse.

York, NY). Velvety and palate-coating, this rum-based liqueur has a coffee-with-cream appearance and rich dulce de leche aroma. Vanilla, crème caramel and almond mingle on the palate, finishing with nutmeg and cardamom. The overall combination is reminiscent of chai tea with cream. Consider this easy sipper as a dessert pairing.

Potential Tango Lemoncello (USA; Hotel Tango, Indianapolis, IN). Expect a cloudy, pale yellow appearance and mild lemon aroma with a savory tinge. Overall, this drinks like vodka mixed with lemonade: it's light on the palate, mild and not overly lemony, with the faintest tinge of sweetness and finishing with an appropriate amount of citric pucker.

Martini & Rossi Fiero (Italy; Bacardi, Miami, FL).

Made with a blend of white wines and botanicals including sweet Spanish oranges, this aperitif spirit has a bright orange-red hue and a candied grapefruit aroma. The palate is juicy and moderately sweet, mixing orange-peel and grapefruit-peel bitterness with a sweeter berry hint on the finish.

90 Amaricano (USA; Fast Penny Spirits, Seattle, WA). This American amaro is distilled from West Coast grapes and flavored with more than 40 organic botanicals. The aroma suggests dried cherries and a whiff of menthol. The palate opens mildly bitter. A hint of cocoa nib leads into a medicinal midpalate edged with dried cranberry tartness. The bitter finish is faintly reminiscent of fernet.

Nixta Licor de Elote (Mexico; Casa Lumbre Spirits, Melville, NY). This is a full-on corn liqueur: corn blended with a corn-based spirit. Look for a light honey hue and distinctly corn-y aroma reminiscent of some moonshines. The concentrated palate is mildly nutty and sweet, finishing with a grind of black pepper. Mix with agave spirits. The ear of corn-shaped bottle is an eye-catcher. Made from non-GMO corn.

96 Holmes Cay Guyana Uitvlugt 2003 Single Cask Rum (Guyana; Windyside Spirits, Irving-

ton, NY). A particularly plush and delicious pour, this is a single-cask rum distilled at Demerara Distillers in 2003, aged two years in Guyana, then 16 more in the UK, and bottled in 2021 at barrel proof. Savory baking spices lead the nose, while the palate combines concentrated brown sugar, maple and vanilla. Flashes of milk chocolate, dark fruit and warming, gingery spice grace the finish.

94 Ten to One Caribbean White Rum (Jamaica & Dominican Republic; Ten to One Rum, New York, NY). A blend of unaged, "extra-proof" rums, this is clear in the glass with bright ripe banana aromas. The lively palate sings out with bold banana and lychee, finishing clean with white and black pepper heat.

93 Equiano Rum (Mauritius/Barbados; Park Street Imports, Miami, FL). Distilled and aged a minimum of eight years in Africa and the Carib-

bean, then finished in Cognac and ex-bourbon casks, this rum is on the sweeter side of the spectrum. The amber hue and mild brown sugar aroma lead into a bold palate, with mocha, fudge and toffee slicked with brown butter. Marmalade lingers on the long, cinnamon-spiced finish.

93 Exodus Rum (Jamaica; Proof and Wood Ventures, Bardstown, KY). Look for a bright golden hue and toasty tropical fruit aromas. The palate is distinctively funky, channeling ripe banana, buttered brioche and roasted pineapple. A splash of water adds nutty richness, clove heat and lip-smacking lemon astringency. Sip or mix into tropical cocktails. **Best Buy.** abv: 42%

Denizen Vatted Dark Rum (Guyana and Martinique; Hotaling & Co., San Francisco, CA). This is a blend of 80% dark rum produced in Guyana and 20% unaged rhum agricole from Martinique. The end result is a deep copper hue and rich, toasty aromas of browned butter and toffee. The palate opens with cinnamon, cayenne, mesquite and hint of tropical fruit, then slides into a long mocha finish with lemon and orange peel. Best Buy.

Saison Rum Triple Cask (Trinidad; The Craft Spirits Cooperative, San Mateo, CA). Expect a burnished gold hue and light, rootsy aroma that suggests sarsaparilla and vanilla. The palate feels light and tingly, leading with brown sugar and maple sugar candy, wafting into a gentle, smooth finish tinged with almond and ginger sting. The "triple cask" name refers to a seven-year aging process that progresses through five years in Trinidad, in ex-bourbon American oak casks; 18 months in France's Cognac region in medium-grain French oak; and six months in fine-grain French oak.

Ron Izalco 10 Year Rum (Central America; Phenomenal Spirits, Virginia Beach, VA). The mellow oak aroma includes a smoky hint. Vanilla sweetness leads the surprisingly robust palate, followed by hints of fudge, cocoa powder and a nutty hint. Cinnamon-clove tingle winds into a gentle, mouthwatering finish. Named after a volcano in El Salvador, this blend incorporates rums from Central America including Nicaragua, Panama, and Guatemala.

Aberfeldy 18 Years in Oak Highland Single Malt Scotch Whisky (Scotland; Bacardi, Coral Gables, FL). This starts off with earthy, oaky aromas. The palate opens dry in tones of cedar and a hint of tingly spice. Adding water brings mouthwatering vanilla forward, along with coconut and a nutty tone reminiscent of pecan pie. The finish is long and drying, with plenty of baking spice and ginger tingles. Finished in Côte-Rôtie red wine casks.
